






- Town hall meetings held in all 21 NJ counties.

What Attendees Learned From the Event


% saying they learned a great deal about the following

2019 Town Hall Series

The town hall series will focus on tackling the opioid crisis at the community level by educating residents and gaining a more detailed understanding of how this issue is affecting towns and their residents

Prescriber Education

An online safer prescribing course for Continuing Medical Education credit in compliance with New Jersey law will be available for all prescribers – doctors, nurses, dentists and nurse practitioners – to provide guidance essential for safe and effective opioid prescribing.

Parent Education

A Partnership for a Drug-Free New Jersey study found that nearly one in three parents of New Jersey middle school students do not believe there is a link between prescribed opioids and heroin use. The 5th Grade Parent Alert is a resource guide for parents of New Jersey's fifth grade students to educate and raise awareness of the current opioid crisis, the signs and symptoms of opioid dependency and abuse, and prevention and intervention strategies.




The mobilization will have a dual focus: educating physicians and raising awareness among New Jersey citizens and families.
