ARTICLE II. Underage Restrictions on Private Property [Adopted 8-16-2000 by Ord. No. 00-17]

§ 54-9. Underage possession or consumption.

It is unlawful for any person under the legal age to knowingly possess or knowingly consume an alcoholic beverage on private property, without legal authority.

§ 54-10. Exceptions.

The prohibitions of this article shall not apply to an underage person consuming or possessing an alcoholic beverage:

- A. In connection with a religious observance, ceremony or rite;
- B. In the presence of and with the permission of a parent, guardian or relative who has attained the legal age to purchase and consume alcoholic beverages;
- C. While actually engaged in the performance of employment by a person who is licensed under Title 33 of the Revised Statute of the State of New Jersey; or
- D. While actively engaged in the preparation of food while enrolled in a culinary arts or hotel management program at a county vocational school or post secondary educational institution.

§ 54-11. Violations and penalties; suspension or postponement of driving privileges.

- A. A violation of this article shall be punishable by a fine of \$250 for a first offense and \$350 for any subsequent offense.
- B. In addition to the fine authorized for this offense, the court may suspend or postpone the driving privileges of the defendant for up to six months.
