[§ 67-12.1. Persons under the age of twenty-one years.](#)

A. Prohibition. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to consume any alcoholic beverages within the City limits of the City of Margate City in, at or on any public place, or in, at or on any private place unless said person is in the presence of his or her parent or guardian.

B. Enforcement on private property by private persons. Any private person seeing a person under the age of 21 years consuming alcoholic beverage in violation of this article may make a complaint against said minor.

C. Enforcement on private property by police officers. Police officers may make a complaint when in the course of the officer's investigation, while lawfully on private property, the officer determines that a person under the age of 21 years has consumed alcoholic beverage in violation of this article.
