ARTICLE II. Consumption in Public Places [Adopted 11-12-1975 by Ord. No. 27-75]

§ 50-11. Consumption restricted. [Amended 9-13-1977 by Ord. No. 13-77]

- A. No person shall consume alcoholic beverages while:
 - (1) In or on a public street, lane, sidewalk, public parking lot or in any public conveyance.
 - (2) In a private motor vehicle while the same is in motion or parked in any public street, lane or public parking lot.
 - (3) Upon any private property not his own without the express permission of the owner or other person having authority to grant such permission.
- B. No person shall discard alcoholic beverage containers upon any public street, lane, sidewalk, public parking lot, public or quasipublic place or upon any private property not his own without the express permission of the owner.

§ 50-12. Violations and penalties. [Amended 9-13-1977 by Ord. No. 13-77]

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or be imprisoned for not more than 90 days, or both.
