

**TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE**

**ARTICLE I Consumption and Possession [Adopted by Ord. No. D-109 (Sec. 4-18 of the 1973 Revised General Ordinances)]**

**§ 30-1. Consumption and possession in private and public places; open containers.  
[Amended 10-20-1980 by Ord. No. D-327]**

No person shall consume any alcoholic beverage on any private place without permission of the owner or person in lawful possession or joint possession thereof or within or outside any motor vehicle on any public street or public place other than a place licensed to sell alcoholic beverages and dispense alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises in the Township. Nor shall any person have in his possession or in the joint possession with another or others any open container containing alcoholic beverages at, within or outside any motor vehicle or on any public street or public place other than a place licensed to sell alcoholic beverages and dispense alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises. *Editor's Note: Original Sec. 4-18.2, Special waivers, which previously followed this section, was deleted at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art.
