

TOWNSHIP OF WALL
ORDINANCE NO. 33 - 2000
AN ORDINANCE OF THE
TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL
AMENDING AND SUPPLE-
MENTING "THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL,
1977" AS AMENDED AND SUP-
PLEMENTED, CHAPTER VI,
"ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE
CONTROL", SECTION 6-5,
"PERSONS UNDER 21 YEARS
OF AGE." TO PROHIBIT THE
POSSESSION OR CONSUMP-
TION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVER-
AGES BY UNDERAGE PER-
SONS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY
UNDER CERTAIN CONDI-
TIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the
Township Committee of the Town-
ship of Wall, in the County of Mon-
mouth and State of New Jersey, as
follows:

Section 1. Chapter VI, "Alco-
holic Beverage Control", Section 6-
5, "Persons Under 21 Years of Age",
of "The Revised General Ordinances
of the Township of Wall, 1977", as
amended and supplemented, be and
the same is hereby further amended
and supplemented by the addition
thereto of the following subsection:

"6-5.5 Possession, Consump-
tion of Alcoholic Beverages on Pri-
vate Property.

a. No person under 21 years of
age shall knowingly possess or con-
sume any alcoholic beverage while
on private property within the town-
ship.

b. This ordinance shall not pro-
hibit an underage person from con-
suming or possessing an alcoholic
beverage in connection with any reli-
gious observance, ceremony, or rite
or consuming or possessing an alco-
holic beverage in the presence of and
with the permission of a parent,
guardian or relative who has attained
the legal age to purchase and con-
sume alcoholic beverages; nor pro-
hibit possession of alcoholic bever-
ages by an underage person engaged
in the performance of employment
by an employer licensed to sell alco-
holic beverages or engaged in the
preparation of food while enrolled in
a culinary arts or hotel management
program at a county vocational
school or post secondary educational
institution.

c. Any person who is found to
have violated this section shall be
subject to the following penalties,
which shall be imposed in the mater
set forth in N.J.S. 40:48-1.2:

1. A fine of not more than two
hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars for a
first offense; and a fine of not more
than three hundred fifty (\$350.00)
for any subsequent offense; and

2. The court, in addition to
imposing a fine may suspend or
postpone driving privileges for a
term of not more than 6 months; and

3. The court may also require up
to 180 days of community service.

d. All terms used in this subsec-
tion shall have the meanings set forth
in N.J.S. 40:48-1.2."

Section 2. All ordinances, or
parts thereof, inconsistent with the
provisions of this ordinance be and
the same are hereby repealed to the
extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section,
paragraph, clause or other portion of
this Ordinance be adjudged by a
Court of competent jurisdiction to be
invalid, such judgment shall not
affect or impair the remainder of this
Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall
effect upon its passage and publica-
tion according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the
foregoing Ordinance was introduced
and passed on first reading by the
Township Committee of the Town-
ship of Wall on November 13, 2000,
and further be considered for final
passage and adopted at the Wall
Township Municipal Building, 2700
Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey on
December 13, 2000, at 8:00 o'clock
p.m., or as soon thereafter as the
matter can be reached on the agenda,
at which time and place all persons
interested therein shall be given an
opportunity to be heard, and during
the week prior to and up to and
including the date of such meeting,
copies of said Ordinance will be
made available at the Clerk's Office
in the Township of Wall, Town Hall,
to members of the general public
who shall request the same.
